

# **Executive Pastor**

### Purpose:

The Executive Pastor (XP) is responsible for the overall leadership and direction of church staff in the implementation of the mission of Encounter Church. This includes working collaboratively with the Lead Pastor in leading staff and lay leaders in the process of strategic planning, ministry evaluation, goal setting, and leadership development.

#### Responsibilities:

Proven ability to -

- Empower others through Leadership Development by encouraging others to discover and engage their giftedness and skills in service to the larger community. Strategically engaging with volunteers to assess both the need and fit of the next generation of leaders.
- Work collaboratively with church leaders to provide input into vision development and vision casting
- Lead the ministry **staff** in the establishment and ongoing direction of ministries that effectively insure with Encounter's mission, vision and values.
- Oversees **staff development** and planning of staff meetings
- Facilitate the annual **strategic planning** process including evaluation of ministry performance; and development of key objectives and tactics.
- Champion the development of **organizational infrastructure** through systems and processes in order to support healthy, long-term growth of the church and its people.
- Create a healthy and effective staff culture through development of the following Human Resource
  areas: policies and procedures, overseeing development of job descriptions; staff salaries, hiring/firing
  of staff and resolving conflicts.
