- [Findlay Market](#) – Findlay Market is Ohio's oldest continuously operated public market and one of Cincinnati's most cherished institutions, welcoming more than one million visitors each year. Located just blocks from downtown in Over-the-Rhine, a dense historic neighborhood rich in 19th century architecture, Findlay Market remains the bustling center of farm fresh, locally sourced, artisanal and specialty foods. Open Tuesday through Sunday year round, Findlay Market is home to more than 50 full-time merchants selling meat, fish, poultry, produce, flowers, cheese, deli, ethnic foods and more. On weekends, the Market also hosts a thriving Farmers Market, a vibrant Outdoor Market, numerous street performers and several special events.

Attractions

- [Newport on the Levee](#) – entertainment, shopping and restaurant complex. Adjacent to the Newport Aquarium. Located on the [Southbank Shuttle Trolley](#) route.
- [National Underground Railroad Freedom Center](#) – Located on the banks of the Ohio River, which separated the slave states of the South from the free states of the North during one of the most heartbreaking chapters in our country's history, this museum is a must-visit. The National Underground Railroad Freedom Center shares the stories from the era of the Underground Railroad and helps visitors understand the true meaning of inclusive freedom. An immersive educational experience for children and adults alike, the center offers a combination of permanent and traveling

exhibits that utilize storytelling, film, artwork, hands-on activities, and more. Be sure to check the calendar for special events, including the opening of unique exhibits and discussions on advocating for the end of modern-day slavery.

- [Cincinnati Museum Center](#) – three great museums in one. Open daily until 5:00 PM. A short ride from the hotels.
- [BB Riverboats cruises](#) - Daily sightseeing, dining and unforgettable views. Sailing from Newport Landing on the banks of the beautiful Ohio River, BB Riverboats offers lunch, dinner, kids and holiday cruises, plus many specialty cruises.
- [Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden](#) – This world-class zoo is only twenty minutes from downtown. Accessible by rideshare or public bus.
- [Kings Island](#) - Theme and water park located approximately 30 miles from downtown Cincinnati.
- [Cincinnati Contemporary Arts Center](#) – This wonderful facility is right in the “heart of downtown Cincinnati” at the corner of 6th and Walnut Streets.
- [American Sign Museum](#) – The American Sign Museum is dedicated to the art and history of commercial signs and sign making. The Museum is proud to be the largest public museum dedicated to signs in the United States! Covering more than 100 years of American sign history in 20,000 square feet of indoor space, visitors can walk through the ages of technology and design. The storefront-laden Signs on Main Street display recreates a typical “Main Street USA”, with shop windows full of sign-related objects, curiosities, and samples.
- [Cincinnati Art Museum](#) – The Cincinnati Art Museum is an art museum in the Eden Park neighborhood of Cincinnati, Ohio. Founded in 1881, it was the first purpose-built art museum west of the Alleghenies, and is one of the oldest in the United States.
- [Taft Museum of Art](#) - This Federal-style home-turned-museum features Whistler, Rembrandt, Gainsborough; exceptional collections of Chinese ceramics; and French Renaissance Limoges enamels. Located in downtown Cincinnati.
- [Cincinnati Reds Hall of Fame and Museum](#) – Spanning the history of the Cincinnati Reds from inception to modern times, the museum showcases the world’s largest public collection of Reds memorabilia and artifacts. The hours of operation vary according to whether or not it is or is not a game day (and, off-season / in-season).
- [Ark Encounter](#) – Ark Encounter features a full-size Noah’s Ark, built according to the dimensions given in the Bible. Spanning 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high, this modern engineering marvel amazes visitors young and old. Ark Encounter is situated in beautiful Grant County in Williamstown, Kentucky, halfway between Cincinnati and Lexington and right off I-75.
